



## WEEK ST. MARY COMMUNITY WEBSITE

**Now in our 21<sup>st</sup> year of supporting both parishioners and visitors to our wonderful village, steeped in history.**

With 1,383 images from many of our annual village events and other special occasions going back to the early 1900s, this collection has proved popular with many visitors to the website. In addition, there are over 50 PDFs relating to a variety of interesting historical facts.

On average, over 235 ‘visitors’ are recorded as having accessed the website *daily*! This figure rises considerably during the summer months as our seasonal visitors tour the countryside, looking for interesting villages to explore, and ours is **definitely** interesting. By the end of each year, the annual number of visitors normally increases to over 100,000.

For the past 20 years, the website has been home to the Parish Council’s pages. Although now the Council has their own website, this section will eventually be removed to avoid confusion.

The Week St. Mary website is not just used by going directly to ‘*weekstmaryvillage.co.uk*’ but is referred to on many other websites covering such topics as genealogy and historical matters.

Each month sees the calendar section updated with events, along with the online version of the magazine for those who live further away from the village. Regular sessions of updates and maintenance are undertaken as required.
